## *Proposed area of service*

Borough (Boro) Park Community covers the following. (Map attached)

We start on the western side, from 60<sup>th</sup> Street and 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue. We go north past Maimonides Medical Center until 36<sup>th</sup> Street. (1 block bordering Greenwood Cemetery) till Ft. Hamilton Parkway. We turn left (north) for 2 blocks until 36<sup>th</sup> Street and make a tight turn (south east) onto 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue which meets Church Avenue in the same spot. Continue on Church Avenue (north east) until you reach Coney Island Avenue. Make a right turn and go on the eastern side till you reach Avenue J. Make a left turn continue going west till you come to Bay Parkway. Make a left turn and go at an angle (south west) until you reach 65<sup>th</sup> Street. Make a left turn and go north west till you hit New Utrecht Avenue. Make a left turn continue to go for 5 blocks until you reach 60<sup>th</sup> Street and 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Make a left and go straight bearing west until you come to 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Our starting point, 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 60<sup>th</sup> Street.

This area includes Boro Park, parts of Kensington/ Parkville and it borders Midwood as well as Bensonhurst.

It includes the 48<sup>th</sup> Assembly district as well as part of 49<sup>th</sup>, 44<sup>th</sup>, and 39<sup>th</sup> Assembly Districts. In this area you have the 66<sup>th</sup> Precinct and part of the 70<sup>th</sup> precinct. Community Board 12<sup>th</sup> as well as part of 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> boards.
